PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted, and in fact becomes the bill, LB 835. Now then do we have...

CLERK: Mr. President, I do have an amendment to the bill by Senator Schmit that was printed separately. It is request 2455, Senator.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I withdraw that amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, I believe...Mr. President, Senator Hoagland would move to amend.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Let me withdraw that and refile it for Select File, Mr. Clerk.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp. Motion is to advance the bill from General File, which is debatable. Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: I move we cease debate. We have debated and debated for the last several hours. No one is going to change their position on this. Let's move it.

PRESIDENT: Under the circumstances...Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Microphone not activated.) ...no debate whatsoever on the bill.

PRESIDENT: It is considered that the amendment adopted is the bill. I think there has been debate. I will put the question to you. Shall the debate...Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I object.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I object also, very vigorously.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I don't care how tired these people are, it is a new motion. It is to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: That is correct.
