PRESIDENT: Senator Warner, this is your formal motion to place the bill on General File. May we have order in the Chamber, please. (Gavel.) Senator Warner. Go ahead, Senator. This is your formal motion to place the bill on General File.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, this is also a motion to suspend the rule and place the bill on General File. And, again, to clarify the situation, these claims, civil claims, those of you who are on Judiciary Committee, the Public Health Committee, or Education Committee all recall that your committees have processed these claims and recommended their payment, and that the Appropriations Committee accepted those recommendations and are in the bill as such. The reason that all of these are General Fund payments, on occasions depending upon the type of agency the fund source could be General Funds or Cash Funds, all these happen to be General Fund payments, and the reason that they are added would be a judgment that those amounts were not included in the mainline appropriations to cover these costs, nor should they be, because they would be a cost over and above the operating funds that are recommended in the appropriations bill. So I would ask that the rule be suspended so the bill could be placed on General File and be taken up next week.

PRESIDENT: Senator Haberman, do you have anything further to take up at this time? Very well. Is there further discussion on the motion to place the bill on General File? All right. All those in favor of the motion to suspend the rules and place the new bill on General File vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted on the motion to suspend rules to place the bill on General File. Record the vote.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to place the bill directly on General File.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The bill is on General File. Now we proceed to Final Reading. All members, please take your seats for Final Reading. We will begin Final Reading when members are in your seats in accordance with the rules. Members, please take your seats so that we may begin Final Reading. We will not begin Final Reading until members are in your seats. I would like to ask my red-coated friends to gently persuade some members to take their seats. The Clerk will begin the Final Reading of LB 425.
