PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 425 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 1756-57 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 0 nays, 4 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The majority having voted in the affirmative, LB 425 is declared passed. We proceed to LB 504.

CLERK: (Read LB 504 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 504 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 1757 of the Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. Next we proceed with LB 778.

CLERK: (Read LB 778 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 778 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your voted. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 1758 of the Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 2 nays, 2 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. Proceed to LB 779.

CLERK: (Read LB 779 on Final Reading.)
