SENATOR CARSTEN: The committee amendments, as amended, have been adopted. Now on the advancement...don't have any more amendments...advancement of LB 1230 to E & R Initial, as amended. Senator Schmit, please.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members, the hour is late and many members have already left. And the bill is the committee amendment as amended. Unless there are further lights, I would just move that the bill be advanced as amended.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Is there anyone to speak to the advancement of the bill? If not, all those in favor of advancing LB 1230, as amended, will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Have you all voted? Has everyone voted that cares to? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 1230.
