SENATOR HARTNETT: Thank you, Mr. Chairman.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Okay, we go to General File, then, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SENATOR CARSTEN: LB 1255.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 1255 was introduced by the Business and Labor Committee and signed by its members. (Read title.) The bill was read on March 14 of this year. It was referred to the Business and Labor Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Barrett, on the committee amendments to LB 1255, please.

SENATOR BARRETT: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. As you know, LB 1255 provides for payment of various miscellaneous claims lodged against the State of Nebraska and recommended for approval by the State Claims Board. The committee amendments amount to nothing more than an insertion into the bill of two claims originally denied by the Claims Board. These two claims are for outdated warrants and they do total \$83.60. I would urge the adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Is there any discussion on the committee amendments? If not, all those in favor of adopting the committee amendments to LB 1255 will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Voting on the amendments to LB 1255, the committee amendments. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Committee amendments are adopted. Now, Senator Barrett, on the bill as amended.

SENATOR BARRETT: Thank you, Mr. President. As I have previously mentioned, the bill makes appropriations for the payment of those miscellaneous claims against the State of Nebraska which have been approved by the State Claims Board. The bill also does identify a request by state agencies that are asking for permission to write off certain accounts. These
