LB 1250, 1256

SENATOR CARSTEN: A call of the house has been requested. Do I see five hands? I do. All those in favor of going under call will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Those of you in the Chamber, please return to your seats and register your presence. Those unauthorized personnel on the floor will please move to the side. Those in your offices or wherever you may be, if you can hear me, the house is under call. Please come to the Chamber and register your presence, please. We have six excused. Senator Baack, Senator Chambers, Senator Goodrich, Senator Hannibal, Senator Miller, Senator Hartnett, Senator Pappas, Senator Pirsch, please. Senator Hartnett. There is Senator Chambers. Senator Hartnett, yet, please. Everyone is here, Senator Barrett, that is not excused. Roll call has been requested, Mr. Clerk. Will you call the roll, please.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 1820-21 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 7 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The bill is advanced. We now move to, 1257 is off, we now move to Select File, the appropriations bills, LB 1250, Mr. Clerk. The call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 1250 is on Select File. The first item I have are E & R amendments.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Lundy, would you like to take the E & R amendments to LB 1250, please.

SENATOR LUNDY: Mr. President, I move that the E & R amendments be adopted.

SENATOR CARSTEN: All those in favor of adopting the E & R amendments to LB 1250 say aye. Those opposed no. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Landis would move to amend the bill. Senator Landis's amendment is on page 1662 of the Journal.
