LB 1250A, 1250

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 1250.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Okay, LB 1250 is advanced. Next we move to LB 1250A. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, on 1250A the first order of business are E & R amendments.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Excuse me, did you say committee amendments?

CLERK: E & R amendments.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Oh, E & R. Senator Nichol, do you want to take the E & R amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. President, I move that we adopt the E & R amendments.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The question is, shall the E & R amendments be adopted? All those in favor say aye. Those opposed no. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner would move to amend the bill. (Warner amendment appears on pages 1824-25 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Warner, on your amendment to LB 1250A, please.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this amendment, I spoke of it earlier, is annualizing, it would be more accurate, would be accurate, to have stated that these teachers in which are in Corrections, Social Services and Department of Institutions also had a wage order from CIR affecting the '86-87 salary. The bill that you advanced earlier from Miscellaneous Subjects was for fiscal years prior to '86-87. The dollar amount is \$169,000, no, I added wrong, \$172,000, and the argument on the claims bill, is a court order, this is also the commission's order, so I would move its adoption to be consistent with the other bill. I will tell you I also have an amendment which will follow which are only for those teachers in education which essentially are the visually handicapped and the hearing in Omaha, which is not yet a court order, but this one is, so I would move its adoption.
