SENATOR HANNIBAL: Senator Goodrich was closing on his amendment. The question before you now is the adoption of the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please vote if you care to on the Goodrich amendment. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President, let's have a call of the house and a roll call vote.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: The question is, shall the house come under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: The house is under call. Would you please return to your seats and record your presence. All those members off the floor, please report to the Chamber, the house is under call, and record your presence. All unauthorized personnel, please leave the floor. Please look in front of you and push your button. Record your presence. Senator Conway, Senator Chambers. Senator Hefner, would you record your presence. Senator Lamb, please. Senator Lynch. Senator Morehead, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Senator Withem, Senator Rupp, Senator Pirsch. Senator Scofield, record your presence. The house is under call. Please report to the Chamber and record your presence. Senator Pirsch, please. Senator Goodrich, we have our full complement in the Chamber, about to record, would you care to go with a roll call now? Mr. Clerk, call the roll, please.
