SENATOR McFARLAND: Thank you, Mr. President, and fellow members of the Legislature. This is a legislative resolution to recognize the efforts of the Daughters of the Union Veterans of the Civil War. It is a resolution that was originally going to be introduced by Senator Beutler and since I have replaced Senator Beutler I am delighted to introduce it as well. It recognizes the Daughters of the Union Veterans for their educational, patriotic and charitable works. They have Chapters in Lincoln, Omaha, Fremont, Bellwood, Potter, Beatrice, McCook and Hastings. Last year they celebrated their 100th Anniversary of their formation and along with that they were recognized by having a Federal Charter granted to them on December 9, 1985 by the United States Congress. Therefore, I would respectfully ask that you approve the resolution, the Legislative Resolution that I have passed around, I think the Pages have distributed it, recognizing the Daughters of the Union Veterans for their efforts in the charitable, educational and patriotic endeavors. Thank you. I would urge that you adopt this resolution. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Senator McFarland. Anyone else wish to speak on the resolution 411? If not, the motion is to adopt the resolution. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. You are voting now on Senator McFarland's resolution LR 411. Please record your vote aye or nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the resolution.
