

CLERK: 26 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR LANDIS: The bill is advanced. We will proceed now to the A bill. It does not appear on the agenda, but we'll take it up at this time. It is 1258A. Senator Johnson, on the A bill.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: The Department of Revenue asks for \$10,000 to administer the little income change. Mind you, there is an income change in 1258A, \$10,000 is a modest amount. That is what is in the A bill. I suggest it be advanced.

SENATOR LANDIS: There being no further lights, and, Senator Johnson, you waive closing?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Yes.

SENATOR LANDIS: We'll proceed to a vote on the A bill. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. While we are recording our votes, let me acknowledge on Senator Rupp's behalf 23 third and fourth graders from the Duncan Elementary School in Duncan, Nebraska, accompanied by their teacher. Join me in welcoming these third and fourth graders to the Nebraska Legislature. Welcome. The board has now been open 30 seconds. I had hoped that we could proceed to a final disposition, one way or another, on this amendment quickly, please. Senator Higgins, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR HIGGINS: Point of clarification, Mr. President. You said on the amendment, is it an amendment, or isn't this vote to advance?

SENATOR LANDIS: I'm sorry. It is the advancement of the A bill. Thank you for your correction.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Thank you.

SENATOR LANDIS: The board has now been open for a minute and a half. I'd be interested in having a disposition on this question, one way or the other. The Clerk will record. Senator Johnson, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Better do a call of the house. I don't know where everybody is. Call of the house, please.
