LB 813, 942

SENATOR BARRETT: That's right.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Barrett would move to amend and that amendment is on page 1849 of the Journal.

SENATOR LANDIS: Senator Barrett, on your motion to amend LB 813.

SENATOR BARRETT: Thank you, Mr. President and members, the amendment which I am offering is a result of some work which our staff has done with the Nebraska Catholic Conference. It is found on page 1849, Req. 2822, simply adds these words, "unless consent or relinquishment has been made by the mother or pursuant to Section 43.105 for purposes of adoption." The language, Mr. President, simply clarifies whose consent or relinquishment we are referring to insofar as the bill itself is concerned. Instead of leaving it very broad and very general, we're being more specific. The Catholic Conference, again, the group we've been working for, is supportive of the amendment. I offer it for your consideration. I would hope the body would adopt the amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Senator Barrett. There are no other lights. Would you like to close? Waive closing, we'll proceed to a vote on the Barrett amendment. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Let's proceed towards the disposition of this amendment. For those of you who haven't voted, please do so. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR LANDIS: The motion is carried and the amendment is adopted. Senator Lundy, to move the bill.

SENATOR LUNDY: Mr. President, I move that we move LB 813 to E & R for final.

SENATOR LANDIS: You've heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. Motion carries. LB 942, an Education Committee bill. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, 942 is from Education. I do have E & R amendments to the bill.
