That's what the bill says and those who support it can deny it all they want to and, if they deny that that is their intent, they ought to be in favor of some amendment to stop it from doing that, but they will not accept such an amendment because their intent is not what they say it is. If you're after the smut peddlers, those who do entice these young children or snatch them against their will...

SENATOR LANDIS: Your time is up.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...or by any means put them in these pornographic activities, tailor the bill and focus it on them. But to say you're protecting children while at the same time you make a class of felons out of other children, I think is very ill-advised. So this amendment is not going to weaken the bill. It modifies one phrase.

SENATOR LANDIS: Please close, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I will close my mouth at this point, Mr. Chairman.

SENATOR LANDIS: I know not to be silenced, however. Senator Abboud, followed by Senator Higgins, followed by Senator Hoagland. Senator Abboud.
