SENATOR LANDIS: We are under call. Please return to your seat, check in, call in votes are permitted during the pendency of this and then we'll have a roll call vote. Senators Chronister and Baack. Senators Harris and Goodrich. Senator Pirsch. Senator Morehead. Senator Schmit. Senator Chronister, please check in. Senator Harris. We are all assembled. We will begin a roll call vote. The question before us is a motion to suspend the rules and to vote without further debate on LB 788's advancement. It requires 30 votes. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken as found on pages 1890-91 of the Legislative Journal.) 30 ayes, 12 nays, Mr. President, on the motion.

SENATOR LANDIS: The motion is successful. Senator Abboud has waived his right to close. We will proceed with a vote on the advancement of LB 788. This is normally done by voice vote. Is there a request for a machine vote? In that case we'll have a record machine vote. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. The Clerk will record, and raise the call.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR LANDIS: The bill is advanced. The Speaker has instructed me to pass over LB 890. We'll go on to LB 925, the Cancer Registry bill from Public Health. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, 925 is on Select File. The first order of business are E & R amendments.

SENATOR LANDIS: Senator Lundy, can you help us with the E & R amendments.

SENATOR LUNDY: Mr. President, I move that the E & R amendments be adopted.

SENATOR LANDIS: You've heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wesely would move to amend the bill.

SENATOR LANDIS: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, I'll just take one second.
