LB 850, 949

SENATOR HIGGINS: You see, I am just wondering how this affects OPPD in Omaha.

SENATOR SCHMIT: It should not affect OPPD at all. It affects primarily NPPD and some of their areas.

SENATOR HIGGINS: When one of our directors found that he didn't live in the district after he built a new home, they just went around the law and annexed that territory so he could still be serving, and that is why I am asking you, was there anything like that in what you just read into the record?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Well, I think what happened is that some of us good old boys that lived in the country, Marge, moved to town and we had been on the board when we lived out in the country, and when we get to town, we still want to serve on the board but that little municipality is not served by that power district and so, therefore, so I can continue to exercise my august responsibility as a member of that board, I want to be allowed to do it in this manner.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Thank you, Senator.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Thank you.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Senator Higgins. Senator Schmit, you have closed on your motion to advance, I assume. Is that right?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes.

SENATOR LANDIS: Fine, we will proceed then to the advancement of LB 949. Senator Hall, would you like to make that motion.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I move that LB 949 be advanced from Select File to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR LANDIS: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. The motion is adopted. The bill is advanced. We will move on to LB 850. Senator Morehead's, on behalf of the Governor. Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR MOREHEAD: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and colleagues.

SENATOR LANDIS: Excuse me, Senator Morehead. First the Clerk
