SENATOR MOREHEAD: ...and employ lots of people in Nebraska, you know, I am not opposed to that in any way.

SENATOR MOREHEAD: Mr. President and members, we would ask that the emergency clause be added to this because we do feel it is important that the state have the opportunity to get up and running on this project because the peer review will take some time and just by delaying it that much longer delays the start-up time. So we would ask the adoption of the emergency clause.
