

SPEAKER NICHOL: Thank you. Senator Morehead.

SENATOR LANDIS: Senator Morehead, will you respond?

SENATOR MOREHEAD: Senator Nichol, yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Is the word "Nebraska" going to be on anything in this bill or this corporation or this entity out there? Is the word "Nebraska" going to be into it or is there any way to keep the name of Nebraska off anything that happens, corporation, entity, NDIGC, whatever it is?

SENATOR MOREHEAD: I don't know if that is specifically addressed in the legislation. It creates a research and development authority...just a minute here. It is not cited as Nebraska. It is cited as a Research and Development Authority Act, line 4 and 5 of the amendment which becomes the bill but it doesn't have Nebraska there.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Having been one that signed on to an NDIGC bill, I am awfully gun-shy since that happened, and I have been embarrassed about it ever since I voted for it. So I am very cautious about this bill. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Senator Nichol. Senator Hoagland, you are the last light. He waives. That goes back then to the adoption of the Morehead...sorry, that is right. This is a motion to advance. Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: (Mike off) LB 850 be advanced from Select File to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR LANDIS: You have heard the motion. There has been a call for a machine vote. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. While we are voting, the Speaker has informed me that he wishes to go on to LB 850, A, rather, if that is necessary, and then to LB 768. Senator Higgins, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR HIGGINS: Mr. President, could I ask a question. You said the Speaker wants to go on to LB 850?

SENATOR LANDIS: I'm sorry, 768, after we take up the A bill, if we need to.

SENATOR HIGGINS: 8768.
