LB 890, 997A

PRESIDENT: Senator Baack.

SENATOR BAACK: Mr. President, colleagues, this is an A bill that is for \$6,000. What it is is for the expenses that might be incurred in the Educational Service Unit study that is going to be conducted between now and next session. Four thousand dollars of it goes to the Legislative Council for expenses there, and \$2,000 goes to the state department for getting the study set up. So that is what this is for. I would urge your adoption.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on the bill? If not, the motion is to advance the bill from General File. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record your vote on the advancement of LB 997A. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the A bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. We move to Select File. Everything has been taken care of on Select File down to LB 894, I guess.

CLERK: 890.

PRESIDENT: LB 890.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first item on 890 are E & R amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Sieck, would you care to move for the E & R amendments.

SENATOR SIECK: Mr. President, members of the body, I move that the E & R amendments be accepted.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. The motion is to adopt the Enrollment and Review amendments. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wesely would move to amend the bill. Senator Wesely's amendment is on page 1180 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Don Wesely.
