

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. President, I'd move the advancement of the bill.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 890. Is there discussion? Senator Miller wanted to speak on the bill. Senator Miller. Senator Harris, do you wish to speak on the bill? The motion is to advance the bill. Very well. Senator Miller wanted to speak on the bill. He particularly asked me. Senator Lamb, I'll recognize you.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President, members, I have said about all I have to say about the bill, but I would like to hear what Senator Miller had, had to say. I am also disappointed that Senator Vickers was involved in a symposium this morning and could not be here because I think we expected him to really lead the charge in opposition to the bill. However, just one more time let me say that I consider this an unfair proposition, that the people...some people are trapped. You know, you just can't buy things unless you go to a municipality. If that municipality decides to impose an additional tax, then all the people that are in that trade area are pretty much trapped and have nowhere to go. So with those things in mind, I would ask that the bill not be advanced and I see Senator Miller is back.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Miller if you care to speak on the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR MILLER: Of course I'm against this motion to advance and I think most of us have our minds made up, but if there is a person or a few that don't have their mind made up, take a look at the voting record. The Chairman of the Revenue Committee and the Vice-chairman both voted for the kill motion. I think if two people know the revenue taxing problems in the State of Nebraska and the situation, it should be the Chairman and the Vice-Chairman. I would suggest that if you have a question on this bill at all, that you don't pass 890, that you wait for the tax study. I think that is prudent legislation.
