Morehead, Senator Scofield, Senator Marsh, Senator Harris, Senator Goodrich, welcome. Senator Baack, Senator Rod Johnson, Senator Chizek, Senator DeCamp, Senator Goodrich is just about to record. Senator Hannibal...there you are, Senator Harris. Thank you. Senator Wesely, Senator Pirsch, Pappas, and McFarland, and DeCamp.
