SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I would simply urge the body to move the bill today and whatever time is available I'd be happy to give that to Senator Chambers.

PRESIDENT: Okay. The motion is to advance the bill from Select File.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: I move the advancement of the bill then.

PRESIDENT: Very good. That is the motion, to advance. That was your closing statement. Do you want a machine vote? Very well. Motion is to advance the bill from Select File. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are voting on a motion to advance LB 461 from Select File to Final E & R. Please record your vote, aye or nay. The Chair will allow 45 seconds for you to record your vote. The motion is to advance LB 461 from Select File. Please record your vote. Twenty seconds to record your vote. Please record your vote, aye or nay, on the motion to advance. Have you all voted? Record the vote. Record vote has been requested.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 1213-14 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 13 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries and the bill is advanced. Do you have matters for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir, I do. Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 286, LB 286A, LB 579, LB 579A, LB 775, and LB 950 all correctly Engrossed, signed by Senator Hall. Notice of hearing from the Rules Committee for next Tuesday, signed by Senator Morehead. New resolution, LR 413 by Senators Withem, Beyer, and Hartnett. That will be laid over. Senator Wesely has amendments to LB 965, Senator Landis to LB 1158, Senator Landis and others to LB 43. Senator Miller would like to add his name to LR 385 as co-introducer. PRESIDENT: Is there objection? If not, so ordered.

CLERK: I have nothing further, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Chair will entertain a motion to recess until two...one-thirty? Very well, motion to recess until one-thirty has been made by Senator Nichol. You've heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The
