

noncertified accountants and for that purpose it seems to me that we are simply returning to a standard of behavior that is the more long standing precedent to adopt the amendments and to move the bill. If anything, the noncertified accountants are with respect to the committee amendments adopting new and better standards, ones for themselves which they are willing to meet and, as far as I am concerned, I have no taste for the dirty business of running people out of their livelihoods by state laws. And that is why I intend to support the committee amendments and to support the bill.

I think it was Senator Morehead maybe said, well, maybe they only have two years of accounting or something, or two years. My amendment makes sure they have to have a degree from an accredited university. They passed it out, you can read it. I don't think it is necessary but I am offering it. Now, I do want to quickly deal with the arguments raised by Senator Morehead and let's see, Senator Morehead, who else talked on it, and Senator Lundy and Senator Landis.
