SENATOR CARSTEN: Thank you, Senator Higgins. Senator Hefner, please, on the motion to reconsider the Hartnett amendment.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, I think we ought to go ahead and support the reconsideration motion, and then maybe since this will be a very long bill on Final Reading, and if we have to bring it back for another amendment, it is going to cost a lot of money, so I would suggest that we either hold it or else find another bill to address the problem that Senator Hoagland has on the \$1,000 limit once a month or once a quarter on casino gambling.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Hefner...Senator Vard Johnson, please, on the reconsideration motion.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: I would call the question.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? I do. All those in favor of ceasing debate will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. The question is to cease debate. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Debate has ceased. Senator Warner, would you like to close on your motion? The motion is to reconsider the action or not of the Hartnett amendment. All those in favor of reconsideration will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Have you all voted? Twenty seconds. Have you all voted? Time. Senator Warner.
