SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I guess I would have to ask for a call of the house assuming the count is correct on the board. I assume there must be 6 people unexcused and around somewhere.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Okay, a call of the house has been requested. All those in favor of going under call will vote aye. Those opposed will vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The house is under call. All the senators on the floor will please return to your seats and register your presence. Those outside of the Chamber, please return and register your presence as you come in. The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel, please leave the floor. We have, I believe...17 are excused, 16. Senator Higgins, would you push your button, please. Senator Higgins, would you push your button. Very good. Everyone is here. Shall we...you want a roll call. Roll call has been requested. The question is, shall the...the vote is, shall we reconsider our action on the Hartnett amendment? Those in favor will vote aye, those opposed will vote no and the Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1952 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 4 nays to reconsider, Mr. President.
