CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 1965-66 of the Legislative Journal.) 37 ayes, 5 nays, Mr. President, on the passage of the bill.

SENATOR REMMERS: LB 1251 passes with the emergency clause. LB 1250.

CLERK: (Read LB 1250 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR REMMERS: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1250 become law with the emergency clause? Will you please cast your votes. Has everyone voted that cares to vote? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Began reading record vote.)

SENATOR REMMERS: Senator Warner, did you wish to be recognized? You wish a roll call vote?

SENATOR REMMERS: All those in favor of a roll call vote. Okay, Mr. Clerk, you take the roll.
