

SPEAKER NICHOL: One minute.

SENATOR SCHMIT: So you can understand that the fiscal impact is going to be damaging, it is going to be destructive, I believe it will be unfair. I would like to ask Senator Warner a question, if he would yield, please.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner, please. Senator Warner, would you respond, please.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Senator Warner, I do not see an appropriations bill on 835. But it is my understanding that if the bill is passed in its present form it will require a substantial amount of money for the Public Service Commission. Is that correct?

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Schmit, as you recall, fiscal notes are not placed in the books until after they come off of General File, unless or until amendments are adopted. And then they are placed in the bill books. However any individual senator can request, prior to those adoption, what the impact is. I do understand that a revised fiscal note, based upon the bill as it currently stands, is prepared. And I don't know the dollar amount. I do now.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Since the bill is on special order today, Senator, should not an A bill accompany the bill at this time?

SENATOR WARNER: There is an A bill being drafted to reflect the fiscal note.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I see. But you do not know what the...

SENATOR WARNER: Well, I'm just reading it here.

SENATOR SCHMIT: ...proposed fiscal impact is?

SENATOR WARNER: I see that the Public Service Commission has indicated that the expenditures to implement the bill as amended will be \$926,693 General, and then it reduces to 779 General in '87-88. However, I believe the analyst's figures are substantially less than that, if I can find it.
