SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Pappas, would you like to close on your amendment?

SENATOR PAPPAS: No, I will give Senator Hannibal my closing time.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, Senator Hannibal, would you like to use it?

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Thank you, Senator Pappas, just to let you know that I, the sponsors of the amendment originally, don't have a problem with this. It is a technical clarification. We believe that it is probably already covered in the amendment but, if we want to be double sure and put double language in, fine, we will do it.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, the question is the adoption of the Pappas amendment to the other amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Pappas's amendment to the Hannibal, et al, amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment to the amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Senator, which one would you like to take, Senator.

SENATOR PAPPAS: The one on subsection (2) of this section, that would be the first one you talked about.

CLERK: Okay.

SENATOR PAPPAS: Mr. Speaker, colleagues,...

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Pappas.

SENATOR PAPPAS: This one, what this one does is delete subsection (2) on page 4 of the Hannibal amendment and it reads this section shall not apply after April 15, 1988, or after such time as any federal law or regulation is adopted which sets standards or requirements for telemetry systems, whichever is sooner. Well, basically, what that means is if the FRA decides that they don't need them or anything else that then they don't have to run in the State of Nebraska.
