SENATOR LANDIS: (Microphone not activated.) ...call of the house, if the Clerk would like to record, we can go on to the underlying matter.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right, record, Mr. Clerk. Have you asked for a call of the house? Did you ask for...

SENATOR LANDIS: No.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay.

SENATOR LANDIS: (Microphone not activated.) ...forward and we can go on to the underlying bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: That was what I thought you said.

CLERK: 8 ayes, 10 nays, Mr. President, on the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion fails.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have an amendment from Senator Vickers.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Anybody authorized to take Senator Vickers' motion?

CLERK: Apparently Senator Vickers doesn't want it, Mr. President.
