

out a handout on this. Right now what it does is to limit the increase and decrease of school population from 100 percent down to 10 percent. It doesn't change any more state aid. It simply is a redistributing the formula, the money that is available. So some of you have got cards showing more money that your district got, and so forth. I think it was kind of tied up in committee. We had a 5 percent, and this raises it to 10 percent. I simply ask you to adopt the amendment. I'll answer any questions.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Nelson, please.

SENATOR NELSON: Yes, question of Senator Hartnett. Senator Hartnett, does this bill shift from the...adds increased state aid to the larger schools and cuts it away from the smaller schools, doesn't it?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hartnett, would you like to close on your motion?

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yes, I simply would ask the advancement of the amendment, please.
