SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment is adopted. Anything else, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further on this bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Landis, would you like to move it.

SENATOR LANDIS: I move the advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You've heard the motion. All those in favor of advancing LB 817 say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced, 817.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next bill I have is 963. The first item I have are E & R amendments, Senator.

SENATOR REMMERS: I move the E & R amendments be approved.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted. Anything further?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schmit would move to amend the bill. (Schmit amendment appears on page 1121 of the Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Schmit on LB 963.

CLERK: I have a copy here, Senator, if you need it. It's on page 1121, Senator.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, the amendment that we have here allows the credit unions to accept funds from other sources, state and local governments, political subdivisions, and et cetera. That has been a problem for a few of those credit unions. We have only a few of them that are involved. I move the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DECAMP: Mr. President, I don't think I heard what I thought I heard. Senator Schmit moved to put that amendment to allow, what, the credit unions to adopt or accept public funds and everything, and et cetera? Do whatever you want. I would say that you may remember this was extremely heated issue. I think we've already had one bill that did this identical thing that died on Final with 24 votes or something.
