SPEAKER NICHOL: You have two and a half minutes.

SENATOR PAPPAS: Mr. Speaker, colleagues, this amendment all it allows to do is when there is a failed bank anywhere in the State of Nebraska if nobody will buy that bank, if nobody comes in and buys that bank, it allows for the Banking Director to allow an adjoining bank from an adjoining county to come in there and put a branch in or put a facility in where that failed bank was. This would allow the banking service to continue in the small communities. It was a bill in committee. It came out on consent calendar, basically. We never did have time for it yet. I ask for its adoption.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the amendment. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the second Pappas amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: It is adopted. Anything else?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Harris would move to amend.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Harris.

SENATOR HARRIS: Mr. President, since we only have a minute left, I think I'll withdraw my amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: It is withdrawn. Anything else, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing further on the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. Are we on 1025?

CLERK: Yes, sir, just a second, please.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 1025. LB 1208, 1051, all right. Senator Chizek.

CLERK: Mr. President, 1051, I have E & R amendments first of all.
