LB 900, 900A, 1048

CLERK: I have nothing further on that bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote (sic) aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk, we didn't do 1048, did we? It has an A bill. And 1005.

CLERK: Mr. President, I might suggest there is an A bill on 900.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Fine, Senator Sieck.

CLERK: Senator, Senator Sieck has an amendment to LB 900A. (Sieck amendment appears on page 2001 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR SIECK: Yes. The amendment to the A bill, 900A, is because of 848. Now because of the amendment, it is a cash flow amendment. They are both the same. We have to write a new bill so that...it is a combination of the two. I move we advance it.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay. The question is the advancement of the A bill. All in favor say aye. I'm sorry. The question is the adoption of the Sieck amendment to the A bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the Senator Sieck's amendment to 900A. I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, the question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. Senator Goodrich, would you come here, please. Senator Goodrich, please. Moving on to LB 1048.

CLERK: Mr. President, 1048,...

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Remmers, please.

CLERK: Just, just...Senator, give me just a moment, would you. I do have E & R, Senator.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, Senator Remmers.
