SPEAKER NICHOL: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are approved.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have an amendment to the bill by Senator Chambers. Senator, this is your amendment on page 1432.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Members of the Legislature, this is an amendment agreed to by Senator Goodrich, myself, the Omaha School District, and everybody involved. And it simply makes the divestment law, that applies to every other school district in the state, now apply to the Omaha district. And it gives them three years from the date of passage of this bill to comply, so that they are on the same footing as every other school district in the state right now. And I'm asking its adoption.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion?

CLERK: Senator, just, excuse me, just so we are clear. You are withdrawing the one that you had filed earlier, and this is the substitute amendment?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, this is the substitute that puts in a correct date. (Chambers amendment is printed on page 1954 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion? If not, the question is the adoption of the Chambers amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: It is adopted. Do you have anything further?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right. The question is the advancement of the bill. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced, 1048. LB 1005.

CLERK: Mr. President, 1005, the first item I have on it are E & R amendments.
