SPEAKER NICHOL: It is adopted. Anything...

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next bill for consideration is LB 289, and I do have a series of amendments to the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay.

CLERK: The first amendments I have are E & R amendments, Mr. President.

SENATOR REMMERS: I move that the E & R amendments be approved.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are approved. Shall we pull it? Okay, we'll skip 289. Go to 960.

CLERK: Mr. President, I do have E & R amendments on 960, Senator.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Remmers.

SENATOR REMMERS: I move that E & R amendments be approved.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are approved.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have an amendment from Senator Lamb to the bill. It is on page 1859 of the Journal.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hartnett can handle that.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. Speaker, I'll take the amendment for Senator Lamb. What this does, beginning this fall, it will change the numbering system on referendums. So rather than beginning at 300, it will begin at 400. I simply move that we advance this amendment to my bill. Thank you.
