SENATOR CARSTEN: Any objections? So ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Lamb has amendments to be printed to 525; Senator Landis has amendments to LB 43. (See pages 2064-66 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, there will be a meeting of the Appropriations Committee at one o'clock in Room 1003 today.

Senator Warner would move for LB 778 to become law notwithstanding the objections of the Governor. That will be laid over, Mr. President.

And LB 325 is reported correctly enrolled, Mr. President. (See page 2067 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, Senator Schmit would move to bracket LB 1258 so as to follow LB 539 on Select File.

SENATOR HALL: I object.

SENATOR CARSTEN: There is an objection. Motion is withdrawn. Anything more, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: No, sir, I'm finished reading.

SENATOR CARSTEN: We do have three Select File bills that I believe we can move. They won't take very long. Is that okay, Mr. Speaker? Senator Hall, LB 1258.

CLERK: Senator, 1258, I have E & R amendments to the bill.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I move the E & R amendments be adopted.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The question is the adoption of the E & R amendments. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted. Senator Hall.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I'd move that LB 1258 be advanced from Select File to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The question is, shall LB 1258 be advanced? All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. So ordered.
