SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I'd move adoption of the amendment as explained.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You've heard the motion. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment is adopted. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the bill be readvanced to E & R Grossment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You've heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. May I please introduce some guests in the north balcony this afternoon. We have one notable person, Mr. Gary Cooper, would you please stand up. There is Mr. Gary Cooper in the north balcony and he is the teacher of 20 seniors at Sargent Public High School and Senator Rogers. These folks are guests of Senator Rogers. CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner would move to return the A bill for a specific amendment.
