SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move the E & R amendments be adopted.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion to adopt the Enrollment and Review amendments. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: I have an amendment from Senator Schmit to indefinitely postpone the bill. Senator, that was filed before I think. Mr. President, I now have an amendment to the bill from Senators Rupp and Schmit. It is found on page 2008 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members, the amendment which we have proposed would place into statute the provisions of Initiative 300. The reason for this being that in the event that there would be an adverse court ruling to the entire Initiative 300 proposal, then there would still be statutory protection for the public in the way of the language that is contained in Initiative 300. But since the proponents of Initiative 300 do not wish that to be put into statute, Senator Rupp and I ask your permission to withdraw that amendment.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is withdrawn. May we have your indulgence for just a moment, please. We are going to leave now the agenda of LB 300, and proceed to LR 16CA.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 16CA is a resolution that was introduced by Senators DeCamp and Baack. It would propose an amendment to Article XII, Section 8 of the Constitution of the State of Nebraska. The resolution was introduced last year. The Constitutional Revision and Recreation Committee reported the resolution indefinitely postponed. There was a motion to raise the resolution. That prevailed. Mr. President, the first motion I have...then there was a motion to kill the resolution that was adopted on January 27 of this year. There was a motion made by Senator Lynch to reconsider that action and that motion prevailed. The resolution is now on General File. The first order of business I have is an amendment to the resolution by...

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator DeCamp, the Chair recognizes you to explain and make the foundation. You have ten minutes.
