CLERK: Senator, I think I am on the other one. This is the one that says, "or fails to plug or plugs an abandoned well." That one we printed in the Journal, Senator, and that is on page 1322.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I see. Yes, this amendment corrects the problem that Senator Vickers raised on General File about the failure to plug or take care of the abandoned wells and I move the adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes, Mr. President, this amendment is one that was explained previously which harmonizes the provisions of LB 310. In one section of the bill we spoke about certified mail and in the other we spoke...and or registered mail. In another we spoke about only registered mail. My amendment will clarify that the notice will be required to be sent by registered mail. I urge you to adopt the amendment.
