Would it be possible for you to allow us to discuss LB 31 which is Senator Warner's bill immediately after 539 and then we can use LB 539 to discuss the sales tax and LB 31 to discuss the income tax.

SPEAKER NICHOL: I had intentionally inserted LB 31 after 539 at the suggestion of Senator Warner for today, so the answer is, yes.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. In that case, what I will do is I will withhold the income tax amendments to LB 539. I will put them on LB 31 and let Senator Warner deal with the sales tax amendments to LB 539.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Is that agreeable to you, Senator Warner. All right.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hefner had an amendment to the bill. Senator, I think this one was probably filed...I am not sure when. I think it is from last year though. Okay.

SPEAKER NICHOL: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is offered by Senators Smith and Warner. It is found on page 1849 of the Journal.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Smith and Warner, on your motion.

CLERK: Senator, you should note that this is the first amendment that you had filed.

SENATOR WARNER: I want the second one.

CLERK: You want the second.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The first one is withdrawn then.

CLERK: Senator Johnson, you had an amendment. Senator, again I think it goes to the income tax issue that you printed. All right. Mr. President, Senator Smith and Warner would move to amend and that amendment is on page 2090 of the Journal.
