That is what chemical does and that is what chemical does to us as individuals, as human beings. So we do have to be careful what we do with chemicals and I feel that it is very, very important to watch what you are doing. Now, it is immaterial to me how you vote on this particular issue. I mean, if you want a study, but I do know that we have to address it. We have to let the railroad know. We have to let the highway department know that they have to be careful with this product. It is hurting us and it could destroy us, and all the chemicals...and that speaks for all the chemicals, not just 2,4-D ester. But I do want to make this clear that these things are dangerous to our society and we as farmers have to watch what we are doing with them. I encourage you to support the amendment.
