LB 783, 1177

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Sieck would move to amend his bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Sieck.

SENATOR SIECK: Mr. President and members of the body, this is a technical amendment. Many changes had to be made. As you know earlier, this was a word change in from mentally retarded or from insane to mentally retarded and such like. And part of it was educable and we needed to make that more clear and this is the reason for the amendment. It really doesn't change the impact of the bill at all.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Senator. Is there discussion? Then the motion is to adopt the amendment by Senator Sieck to 1123 (sic). All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are voting on an amendment by Senator Sieck to 1123 (sic). Please record your vote aye or nay. May we have your attention, please, to the motion on the floor, an amendment by Senator Sieck to...amendment by Senator Sieck to 1177. Please record your vote aye or nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Sieck's amendment.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Senator Hall, I have nothing further on this bill, Senator.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move that LB 1177 be advanced from Select File to E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion to advance 1177 from Select File. Al' those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. The motion carried, the bill is advanced. LB 783.

CLERK: May I read some things in.

PRESIDENT: Yes, matters for the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I might, I have a Rules Committee report regarding action on a proposed rules change that was initially offered by Senator Morehead. (See pages 2116-17 of the Legislative Journal.)
