LB 645A, 782, 783, 1258, 1258A, 1259

Senator Warner has amendments to 645A to be printed. (See pages 2117-18 of the Legislative Journal.)

LB 782, 1258, 1258A and 1259 are reported all correctly Engrossed, Mr. President. Those are signed by Senator Hall.

Mr. President, LB 783. Senator, the first item I have on 783 are E & R amendments.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move the E & R amendments be adopted.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the Enrollment and Review amendments. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beyer would move to amend the bill and Senator Beyer's amendment would add the emergency clause. (Senator Beyer's amendment appears on page 2119 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Beyer.

SENATOR BEYER: Mr. Speaker and colleagues, I wish to add the emergency clause because, in the hard and tight economic times that we have, this particular bill is based on what we have been losing. It is about \$2500 a month so we could pick up about \$7500 over the next three months by adding the emergency clause rather than let it become law regularly. So, with that, I would ask your adoption of the emergency clause.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion? If not, the motion is to adopt the emergency clause as an amendment by Senator Beyer. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please give attention, please, to the emergency clause amendment to LB 783. Record your vote aye or nay, please. The motion is the emergency clause. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the emergency clause as offered by Senator Beyer.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Jim Pappas would move to indefinitely postpone the bill.
