

be superfluous. But in case it is vetoed, we wouldn't lose the noncontroversial parts of LB 325. So I would ask your support for the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The motion is the amendment by Senator Wesely. Do you wish to speak on the amendment, Senator Pappas? Do you wish to speak on the Wesely amendment, Senator Pappas? Very well. The motion is the adoption of the amendment by Senator Wesely to LB 311. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. May we have your vote aye or nay, please, on the Wesely amendment to LB 311? May we have your vote aye or nay, please. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays. Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment to the bill.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wesely would move to amend and this amendment is on page 2014 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Okay, this is the lump sum provisions, I believe, isn't it? Okay. Senator Miller. Senator Miller or Senator Lundy. Senator Lundy, if I could have your attention. Senator Miller and Senator Lundy both had concerns about lump sum for state employees. This thing we adopted in 325 dealt with the problem that we could have a lawsuit and lose it over. This would have the same provisions for county employees. So I am taking Senator Miller's amendment to 325 and applying it to county employees so that we don't lose that lawsuit and have to give up lump sum completely. So, hopefully, you will agree to put this on. The language is there to adopt it exactly as we did for the state employees and it is the same system plan so we thought we had better do that while we could. I think there is an amendment to that, isn't there, Pat?

CLERK: Yes, sir, you have an amendment to the amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR WESELY: Okay, there was a drafting error in this that we need to adopt. Because we took the exact same language as the state employees have now, "state" employee was inserted in one place when it should have been "county" employee. So I would ask for this amendment to the amendment and then adoption
