

intent, but it does make it a little tighter bill on that. We do require an annual report from the tax commissioner on the amount of investment of the state provided through this bill, the number of jobs created by each taxpayer claiming this credit and the total amount of credits claimed in the state so every year this body will know exactly how much they're getting for their money in terms of lost revenue and there will be complete disclosure provided through this legislation so that the Revenue Department and the public will know who is receiving what and what we're getting for our money which is a very important aspect that the Governor wanted to have in the bill. And then finally there will be what is called a high noon clause to the bill so that ten years after the implementation date a review will take effect of its effectiveness and we'll look at those reports and recommend whether or not it ought to continue or not. So I'd ask your support for these amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Vard Johnson. Senator Vard Johnson, did you wish to speak on the Wesely amendment?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: No, I wanted to speak on the bill.
