But I just don't see that it is going to give us that much of a problem. Most of your turkeys are confined and everything and about the only problem we have as I see it is land and calves. Senator Higgins would like a few minutes of my time, so I yield to her.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Higgins, please.
