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Governor run the state. I think that to bring this back and go through this process again, making some analysis of do we want to change or do we not want to change, is another continuing waste of time. I am opposed to it. Let's move forward, stick by our decision, whether it is right or wrong, either override or not override, whatever, and go from there. But I think we need to put our backbone where our mouth has been and stay hitched. Thank you, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Thank you. Senator Marsh, please.

SENATOR MARSH: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature. I want to speak to Senator Harris's proposal for I do not support recessing until the middle of May. Shirley Marsh is not up for reelection this year, but those of you who are should be very cautious. Your constituents could very easily feel you do not have backbone and you don't want them to know what you are going to do before the primary election. That does not appear to be a good way to go into a primary election, in my estimation. I will not support the postponement until May. I will support the postponement until Wednesday of next week for our adjournment. That sounds to me like a rational decision so that we have time for processing, we have time because the Governor chose not to return the bill today or yesterday. We do not want to play into anyone's hands unnecessarily. We need to take the responsibility for what we do, and a wise decision would say we need that time next week. Thank you very much.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hall, please.

SENATOR HALL: Question.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, the question has been called. The other light went off, Senator Hall, so we won't need to go through that. Senator Warner, would you like to close on what is before us.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I just want to make it clear. The purpose is not...the purpose is not to have another meeting with the executive trying to find some group in here that agrees with him, or he with some group in here. The purpose is pure and simple that whatever vetoes in the total dollar amount that he will make, he will make independently, as he should, under the Constitution. All we are saying is let's have three days after today, before Monday, to analyze what those are, so when we come back Monday you will know what the impact of any
