

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay to cease debate, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Debate has ceased. Senator Johnson, would you like to close on your amendment, please.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Yes, thank you, Mr. President. I think it is important that this issue be brought before the Legislature today and for the Legislature to have a worthwhile discussion on this issue because clearly it is one of the more important issues facing agriculture. Double jeopardy has been around for a long time and it is something that we need to solve and get behind us. I think Nebraska, as Senator DeCamp explained earlier, we have a system set up in this state that is probably further along or ahead of most other states and it would be, I think, inappropriate for us at this time to completely scrap that system and say that we are going to go with the direct notification process rather than utilizing something that we have spent. As I said, a lot of money and a lot of dollars to set up and all this bill does is allow us to certify the Secretary of State as a legitimate place to file those liens. I think that it is sensible and the correct approach to go and so I would urge the body to return the bill to adopt this amendment.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The question is not to adopt the amendment but to return to adopt the amendment. So we are voting on the return to Select File for a specific amendment. All those in favor of that motion will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. The question is to return LB 603 for a specific amendment. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Fifteen seconds and then I am going to call the vote. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk. Senator Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Yes, Mr. President, I think this is a significant issue. I would like to see the house come under call and we will have a roll call vote on the motion to return.

SENATOR CARSTEN: We are on Final Reading so you should just check in. You should be in your seats anyhow but press your green button to be sure everyone is here and then we will have a roll call vote. It has been requested.
