SENATOR CARSTEN: Thank you, Senator Nelson. Senator DeCamp, do you want to close on your amendment, please.

SENATOR DECAMP: Mr. President, this amendment is independent of the issue that Senator Johnson was addressing. We do have a central filing system. These are, if you would, I will use the phrase "technical amendments" brought by that central filing council to correct any shortcomings and give the authority to do necessary things. They are independent of the issue of double jeopardy. They are independent of the issue of whether you should or shouldn't have a central filing system. I guess I can't imagine anybody opposing the amendments themselves.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Okay, Senator DeCamp was closing. The motion is to return LB 603 for a specific amendment. All those in favor will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. The Chair would remind the body that the call has not been raised. We are on Final Reading which means that you should be in your seats. The question is to return to Select File for a specific amendment by Senator DeCamp. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on adoption of the motion to return.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Okay, the bill is back on Select. Senator DeCamp, do you want to move for the adoption?

SENATOR DECAMP: Yes.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The question is the adoption now of the DeCamp amendment to LB 603. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, I have to acknowledge John's cleverness. It makes me think of myself when I was a kid. They want to delay this bill. They could not get the votes to bracket it so they bring up some amendment and tell you to return the bill and adopt an amendment which may or may not have any meaning and that delays the bill. So he achieved through stratagem what he couldn't achieve directly. You saw one no vote up there and maybe it doesn't matter to anybody else whether this particular type of centralized filing or that system is put in place or not. But when Senator Vickers said that delaying this bill will give more time to be lobbied by the bankers, what he should have said was
