SENATOR HARRIS: And on behalf of Alan Beermann, I will present them with a certificate that is commemorating this event and thank you. I would move the adoption of the resolution. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Senator Harris. Is there anyone else that wishes to speak on the resolution? If not, the motion is to adopt the resolution offered by Senator Vickers and Senator Harris. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote. We usually say, Mr. Harris, please record your vote aye or nay on the congratulatory resolution. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the resolution.

PRESIDENT: The resolution is adopted and the congratulations of the Chair go with it to my personal friend, Mr. John T. Harris and Mrs. Harris on this occasion. Now then, we proceed into LB 911.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 911 is on Select File. I do have E & R amendments pending. However, Mr. President, I do have amendments to the E & R amendments, but I also have a priority motion.
