CLERK: Senator Pappas, a second amendment.

PRESIDENT: Withdrawn.

CLERK: Withdraw them all, Senator?

SENATOR PAPPAS: Yes.

CLERK: Senator Hefner, I had an amendment from you, Senator, 2958, inserts a new section.

SENATOR HEFNER: Yes, Mr. President, this we had incorporated this amendment into the one that I had to E & R, so what this does is add the \$6,000 Cash Fund. This would allow the commission to print the rules and regs and charge for it and take in money. We do have this in the bill, but the fiscal office informed me that we needed to get this part in the bill too, so I would move for the adoption of this amendment.

PRESIDENT: I have a list of speakers here, or lights at least. I'll go through them. Senator Landis, on the...Senator Vard Johnson. Senator DeCamp. Do you wish to speak on this Hefner amendment, Senator DeCamp? Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, at the suggestion of some of my colleagues I ask to withdraw this amendment as it is included in one of the following amendments coming up.

PRESIDENT: Very well, Senator.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I then have is...Senator Hartnett, I assume you agreed to withdraw that amendment that you co-sponsored with Senator Pappas?

SENATOR HARTNETT: (Microphone not turned on immediately.) ...statement and then withdraw the amendment. I guess my concern is not with the issuance of new license. I think that that should be up to the local control of issuing new license and setting standards and so forth, but I guess what my big concern is, and what my amendment addressed, which I am going to withdraw, deals with renewals and revoking of license because I can see it on the local level becoming a political football where they may give a license to Senator Landis's bar and not maybe to Senator Higgins' bar, so that's my really concern and my amendment addressed that but I think I'm simply going to
