SENATOR HABERMAN: I have a question of Senator Warner.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner is available.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Senator Warner, do you have a specific purpose you want to use this bill for some reason?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes, this funds LB 835.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Pardon?

SENATOR WARNER: This bill funds LB 835, the telephone bill. Oh, I explained the one about 31. I'll be glad to repeat it on the floor for you.

PRESIDENT: Is that all, Senator? The motion is to advance LB 835A and please record your vote aye or nay. Select File. We are on Select File. All those in favor of advancing 835A say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. The bill is advanced. We move then to 600A.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator, there are no E & R amendments, Senator. I do have...there was a motion made by Senator Hoagland, which was adopted, to bracket 600A, Mr. President. I assume...

PRESIDENT: It's up for consideration now. Senator Hoagland, do you wish to formally unbracket the bill first so we can take it up?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Yes, I will move...I will ask unanimous consent to unbracket LB 600A.

PRESIDENT: Is there objection to that unanimous consent request? Hearing none, so ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to amend the bill. Senator Chambers would also move to suspend Rule 7, Section 3(d) to permit consideration of his amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers.
